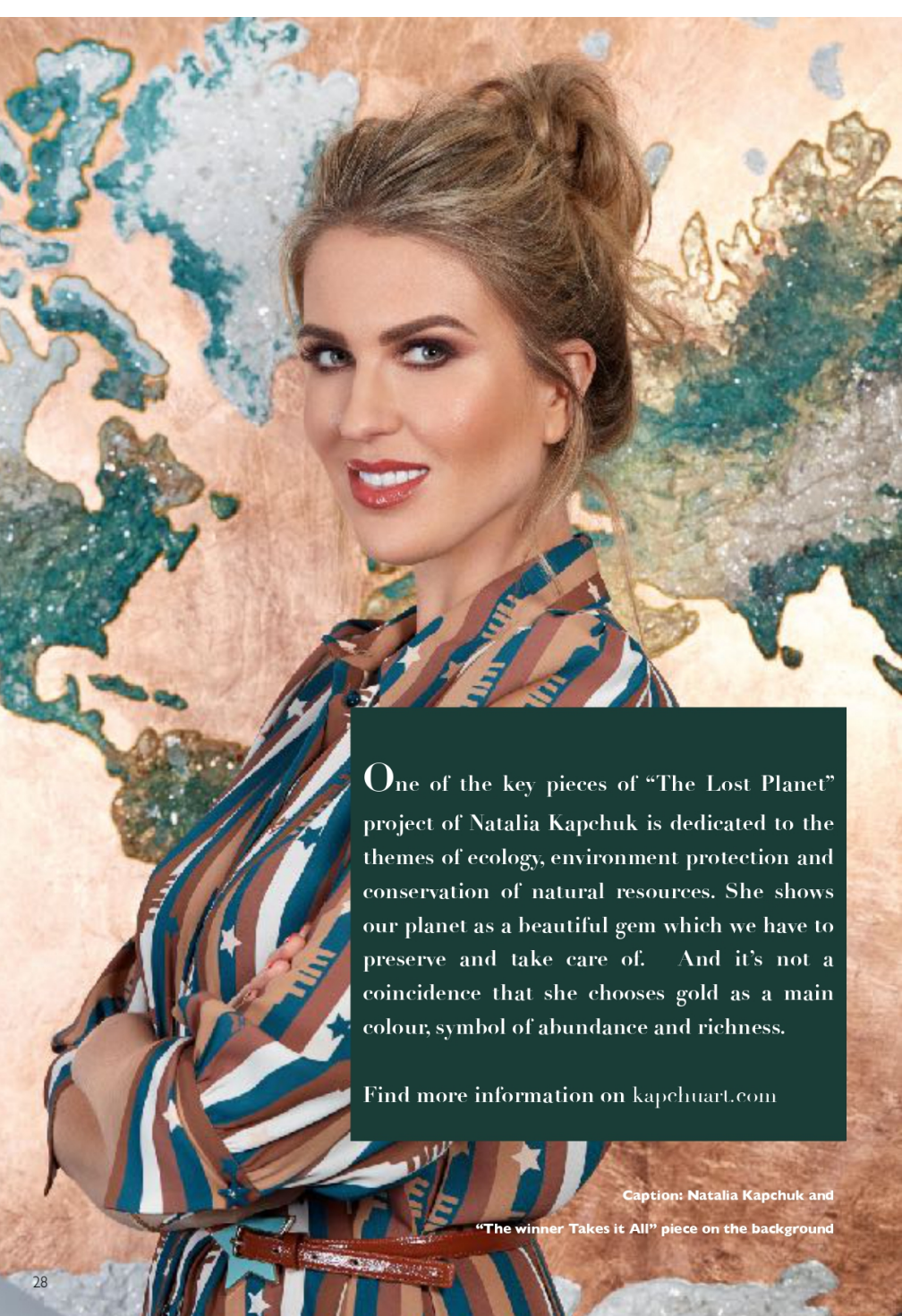
THE PLANET MADE OF GOLD
